## UN CONFERENCE ON DISARMAMENT ISSUES ON "MOUNTING CHALLENGES TO PEACE AND SECURITY AND DISARMAMENT TODAY" TO CONVENE IN SAPPORO, JAPAN, 26-29 JULY

NEW YORK, 13 July (Department for Disarmament Affairs) – A United Nations Conference on Disarmament Issues will be held from 26 to 29 July 2004 in Sapporo, Japan, to address new challenges to nuclear disarmament and non-proliferation.
