The IIEA publishes its recommendations for policy decisions provided next G8 Summit in Belfast on June 17-18.

In the last 10 years, we have seen important economic and development changes world wide. Despite that, the conditions of half of the world pop population are not improving as expected. Important phenomena, like land grabbing and climate change contributed to worsen the situation of developing countries. In addition the Western powers seem not to take into consideration the whole world situation and the economic disparities. As the G8 is an important and influent inter governmental summit, the IIEA urges the constituting countries to reach an agreement for a final commitment towards world equality and safe food. In particular, we underline the growing importance of the phenomenon ~~of~~ of land-grabbing as a dangerous phenomenon that could worsen the poor est part of the world population.

Land grabbing is a new phenomenon, born 10 years ago, by which mostly Western countries and African gov governments, to gether with Western food corporations, buy developing countries' land to produce and export food. The main concerns of this phenomenon are that local farmers are lo ing land and food and moreover, the outcome produce from these Western actors is often exported to the producing country.

consideration environmental damage and ecological

International Sustainability co-founder and CEO,
parties, with a more effective management
of ~~the~~ land grabbing issues a consistent change
to sustainability and equity is possible.

~~A~~ A more equitable consumption and production
of food together with appropriate and ecological
techniques of agriculture can either save the
planet's warming and help developing countries
to grow. Mr. McNeilan says that teaching developing
countries sustainable ways to cultivate (regenerative
agriculture) could reduce the negative effect of
land grabbing. The financial capital of the
world's population can be inverted in these countries'
agriculture. This could bring global economic

development and care to the local farmer's situation. Together with the support to developing countries come the attention for an ecological and sustainable exploitation; says McNahon. Techniques of the regenerative cultures to improve food disposal and territorial fertility.

Considering McNahon's assumptions, and the current world situation of inequality, the ILEI asks formally to the countries of the G8 to deliver a final declaration on the emerging problem of land grabbing and environmental sustainability with the following recommendations:

- the G8 should consider and discuss whether countries and cooperation strategies to transform land grabbing in a resource for developing countries;
- the G8 should identify and clarify the positive and negative outcomes of land grabbing
- the G8 should structure an aid programme to help local farmers to resist and benefit from land grabbing.
- the G8 shall exist and discuss future international rules regarding international land grabbing
- the members of G8 shall consider and discuss the environmental negative outcomes of

land grabbing and find practicable solutions.

Finally, the ILED suggests the GP ^{calling} to declare its full commitment to the land grabbing phenomenon ~~and~~ in order to transform its negative effects in a resource for the growth of developing countries.
